

## North East Bushrangers TOUR 2022 - RULES FOR PLAYERS

1. The team/s will move and have meals together at all times. Individual players cannot make arrangements to take meals or travel alone or in small groups, except with the Team Manager's permission.
2. Players must be punctual for all training sessions and any other appointments organised by the Team Manager or Coach.
3. The use or possession of alcohol, drugs and tobacco products is strictly forbidden.
4. Games involving gambling for money are not permitted.
5. Players are to inform the Team Manager and Coach immediately of any health problems or of any injury sustained.
6. Players are to notify the Team Manager of any prescription drugs being taken as they may be subject to restrictions under the Basketball Australia Anti-Doping guidelines.
7. To avoid damage to furniture and fittings players are not permitted to enter rooms of other players without the permission of the Team Manager. These visits are to be kept to a minimum. No exceptions.
8. Players are not permitted to behave in any way which harms, intimidates, victimises, undermines, offends, degrades or humiliates another player or person. RESPECT For all is key!
9. Appropriate uniform must be worn on all occasions as directed by the Team Manager.
10. Players must observe all curfews and must not leave the accommodation venue, other than for games, training sessions itinerary etc, without the express permission of the Team Manager. (Team Managers must know your location at all times)
11. Visitors, not involved with the team includes relatives, may not enter players' rooms without the prior approval of the Team Manager.
12. Players must not enter any room of the opposite gender at any time No exceptions!
13. All players are expected to represent their family, their home Association and their State and the North East Bushrangers with the highest possible standard of behaviour.
14. Mobile Phones/Cameras/Recording Devices - The use of these devices will be controlled by the Team Manager to ensure that they are not used inappropriately particularly in the team accommodation and protect the privacy of players. This may include the devices being handed in to the Team Manager and then time allocated for use.
15. Any player who contravenes these rules is liable to suspension from the team and their actions reported to their parent immediately this will also be reported to home associations and State Officials which may affect future involvement in High Performance Programs

These rules are necessary to ensure that players are looked after and managed whilst away in the highest possible standard of safety and security.

Players are urged to discuss these rules with their parents and to contact the Tour Leader, Tony Long if there is any confusion regarding these rules.
